He acts for liquidators and trustees in bankruptcy and is regularly instructed by the Secretary of State for Business Innovation and Skills in public interest winding up petitions, directors disqualification proceedings, applications for bankruptcy restrictions orders and for the appointment of provisional liquidators. He also frequently acts in professional negligence/indemnity claims, especially where advice as to insolvency and company law is in issue.

Dan is often instructed on applications for urgent injunctions, particularly for freezing orders, acting from start to finish from the initial preparation of the evidence to the final hearing.

Dan is a qualified pilot.
