Professional Negligence and Indemnity

Hafsah has acted and advised in claims against surveyors, valuers, architects and legal professionals.

She was recently seconded to the Professional Indemnity team of a city firm and gained valuable experience in claims against pensions advisers, independent financial advisers and construction professionals as well as professional indemnity issues. She also has experience of claims and issues arising under the Third Parties (Rights Against Insurers) Acts 1930.

Landlord and Tenant

Hafsah regularly acts and advises in possession and forfeiture claims. She acts principally for landlords and has experience of claims against independent sector tenants, occupiers of social housing, trespassers and licensees.

Personal Injury and Travel Litigation

Hafsah has wide ranging experience of travel litigation including claims arising under the Package Travel Regulations, the Athens and Montreal Conventions and the Denied Boarding Regulations, as well as conflict of laws issues.

She is also regularly instructed in employers' liability and public liability claims including claims under the Highways Act and Animals Act.

Employment

Hafsah has experience of claims involving unfair dismissal, constructive dismissal, redundancies and discrimination.

Administrative and Public law

Hafsah has a strong grounding in administrative and public law including human rights. She has experience of appearing in the First-tier and Upper Tribunals in immigration cases and the Administrative Court.

Before commencing pupillage Hafsah spent two years at the Law Commission as a research assistant in the public law team working principally on the project 'Administrative Redress: Public Bodies and the Citizen'. This entailed a comprehensive review of the private and public law remedies available against public authorities. She has also spent time as a researcher for caseworkers at the Public Law Project.
